

Sharepoint Document Phishing - 7/2/2018

These types of phishing emails are becoming more trendy as online storage needs are increasing. This email, while looking somewhat enticing, is actually false. The sender starts off the questions – why would such a weird email address be sending as "Tntech Team"? The next question should be centered around why is there a random "t" located in the middle of the page? These are both signs that this email is not legitimate.
