


Unfamiliar Login Email Phishing - 2/24/2018


The below email attempts to disguise itself as an Office 365 notice, warning the user that they have an unknown login location. While these types of messages are sent out by Microsoft and Google, this one is not legitimate. The "Outlook Corporation" is not real, nor would your account be locked from sending/receiving mail messages. The link below also redirects the user to a webpage in Canada, which is being used to appear it is from Office 365.
