

Helpdesk Phishing - 6/20/2018

Because the Helpdesk is good at what it does, they too are a target of hackers. The below message is made to look like it is sent from the myTECH Helpdesk, but in fact is from an address in Australia. The information is very appealing to recent events, but is in fact illegitimate.

Lets pose a question: if your account has been "indefinitely revoked", how would you be able to login? That's correct, you wouldn't be able to! The link will most definitely navigate you to a page asking for you TTU credentials, which is a hoax. Compromised accounts are in fact inaccessible when deemed compromised, so this is simply another game of phishing passwords.
