


Unexpected Termination Phishing - 7/27/2018

Since the start of the semester is approaching, the number of targeted phishing attempts toward students is on the rise. As previously mentioned, always verify the sender's address. TechCONNECT emails should come from TTU advisement staff. These folks do not have the ability to terminate your email accounts, so this is another clue for phishing. The signature seen below with the email address is also incorrect and doesn't make sense for a legitimate email. Do yourself a favor and trash this message!
